

# Academic Progression

The School is divided into three sections:

- EYC and Kinder (ages 14 months to 5 years) , EYC to Year 1
- Primary (ages 6 to 10), Year 2 to Year 6
- Secondary (ages 11 to 18) Year 7 to Year 13

The school is incorporated to the Mexican Education Secretariat (SEP) and offers recognition up to year 10 (3ro de Secundaria). In Years 11-13 it is recognised by the National University (UNAM) through a revalidation agreement.

The following table shows the correlation between academic progression in the Edron and the Mexican and UK systems.

- The IGCSE is a two year course. Cambridge IGCSE exams are taken at the end of year 11.
- The IB Diploma is a two year course. International Baccalaureate exams are taken at the end of year 13.
